Opening Criteria

Bernalillo County designated as “green” for 2 weeks:

- Rate of spread
- Number of cases
- Number of tests per day
- Test positivity rate
- Contact tracing
- Contract tracing and isolation capacity
- Statewide health care system capacity
- PPE availability

Considerations

- Offer an opportunity for students at every school to stay in 100% remote learning all year
- Maximize learning for all students
- Work within the parameters of PED and DOH guidance
- Accommodate school staff that meet criteria to work from home all year
- Maintain elementary class configurations and secondary master schedules for continuity of relationships all year
- Ensure adult supervision for students who are on campus
- Provide transportation for all students within the qualifying radius
- Ensure that everyone is always ready to return to 100% remote at any time

Overarching Goal January-May: Maximize Learning Opportunities

Guiding Principles:

- Ensure equity and access are embodied in district and school plans.
- Support high quality equity driven instruction for every student.
- Support social and emotional learning and established teacher/student relationships by minimizing disruption to elementary class lists and secondary master schedules.

Flexibility based on current health orders, regulation, and guidance

Primary mode of instruction remains red throughout for instructional continuity

Phase 1 Elementary Small Group

- All students continue to learn online synchronously and asynchronously
- On-campus small groups supplement digital learning
- Small group size determined by current health orders
- Students are not required to attend
- Teachers who must work from home will continue to hold live, digital, differentiated small groups

Phase 2 Elementary Hybrid

- Red will remain the primary mode of instruction for students in the building and at home
- Students who choose to remain online may do so
- Teachers who need to teach from home may partner with an on-campus teacher to share workload
- Students may be in the school building up to 50% of the time

Secondary Small Groups

- All students continue to learn online synchronously and asynchronously (Red)
- On-campus small groups supplement digital learning
- Small group size determined by current health orders
- When feasible, students may also attend electives, CTE, and science labs in small groups for hands-on learning
- Parents may choose for their students to remain in red
- Teachers who must work from home will continue to have live, digital, differentiated small groups

Equity Model
