

## 2024 - 2025 Professional Development Days and Educator Preparation Day

For the 2024-2025 school year, the parties agree to a continuation of district-wide and site-based professional development and teacher preparation during the first week. School sites must decide the focus of each of the days based on consensus achieved through the site's Instructional Council.
